The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) released a report stating elder fraud in 2023 top \$3.4 billion in 2023. Yes, \$3.4 BIL-

LION in 2023 alone! This is an 11% increase.

Fraud targeting seniors – defined as persons over age 60 by the FBI – is a growing concern. We all have received the phone calls trying to sell us products. But, over the years, the scammers have become significantly more sophisticated in their approach. They are able to glean personal information from us with out us realizing it. And with the advances in technology, they are able to even gain access to our computers as well as financial information.

It is not just seniors who are targeted either. Everyone receives unwanted phone calls, text messages, and emails. Be very careful if you do not recognize the phone number, text message and email. Here are examples of some of the most popular scams:

Delivery Notices

You may receive a text message claiming a package cannot be delivered due to an address problem. Or the text informs you an order is ready for pickup. Both of these texts state you need to either contact them at the number provided or click on the link. Ideally, do not open the text. However, if do open it, do not click on any links. And do not call the number on the text message

I caution against blocking the number. It is fine if you do, however, by blocking the number, the scammers will know this is a legitimate number. The scammers are able to send their messages using a different number.

Problems with Anit-Virus

Be careful if you receive an email from your anti-virus company. Recent emails have claimed to be from Norton Anti-Virus (parent company is Symantec) claiming a

problem with the program. The person is told to contact Norton immediately at the phone number provided. The logo and design of the email looks very similar to Norton Anti-Virus. However, the number will be routed to scammers outside of the United States. They will request money to fix the problem and will ask permission to take control of your computer allowing the scammers to download a virus to capture passwords and financial information.

Banking Issues

You receive an email or phone call from bank due to an issue. You will be instructed to call a special number, possibly for the fraud department. It will be a number that is different than the local branch or customer service number. You will be asked to verify your account number and/or your identity thereby giving them access to your accounts.

Government Agencies Email and/or Call

You receive an email from the IRS (or Department of Treasury) stating there is an issue with your tax return. A phone number and/link is provided.

NO governmental agencies will email, text, or call you if there is an issue. All correspondence is done through U.S. Postal Service.

Relative or Friend in Trouble

Almost all of us have received an email claiming a family member or friend is stranded somewhere and needs money. Many times the email will claim the person is out of the country or unable to respond to any phone calls.

A recent twist is to receive a phone call from a person claiming to be a relative in need of assistance. These scammers are excellent in gaining information out of you to make their story even more plausible.

How to Protect Yourself

These are just some examples of the different scams that are out there. There are many more as well. How do you protect yourself? Here are some steps to take to protect your finances and identity.

- 1) **Do NOT answer the phone if you do not recognize the number**
Allow the person to leave a message and you can determine if you need to return the call.
- 2) **Only use known phone numbers**
If you receive a email request or text message for you to call a specific number, do not call that number. Instead, call the number of the local branch or customer service number listed on a statement or card.
- 3) **Do not purchase or agree to purchase any items**
If you did not initiate the call, do not purchase anything.
- 4) **Do not share any personal information, especially financial information**
Never give out bank information, Medicare number, Social Security number, or any personal information. Be cautious of sharing any family information as well. Legitimate businesses will deal with the issue at hand and not ask about your family.
- 5) **Check the return email address**
The scammers are excellent at copying logos and designs on emails. It will look exactly like the company. Check the return email address as the address will not be a company email.
- 6) **Be very careful allowing access to your computer**
If the person requests remote access to your computer, be extremely careful. Only allow trusted persons this access, and only if you initiated a call about a problem not responding to an email.
- 7) **Hang Up**
If you become uncomfortable at any time, end the call, even if the person will not stop pressuring you. It is okay to be rude.

Afraid You Got Scammed

It is easy to get fooled and to get scammed. We all have made decisions we regret later. There is a reason why there are so many scammers – their schemes work. Here are some things to do if you feel you have been scammed:

- Contact law enforcement**
The police may not be able to stop or even recover any losses, but they may be able to. It may also help to prevent future victims. Also, some financial institutions require a police report in order to restore any losses.
- Contact all your financial institutions**
The financial institutions (banks, investments, credit cards) may be able to place a freeze on your account so that no money can be taken. They may also recommend a new account number to be issued.
- Change passwords and have your computer checked**
It is wise to change all your passwords if you have been scammed. If you allowed remote access to your computer, you need to take it in to make sure no viruses have been implanted on your computer. You may need to purchase a new computer.
- Watch all statements very closely**
Immediately report any unusual transactions.

Unfortunately, the scammers will continue to improve and find new ways to glean information and resources from us. We all need to keep our "antennas" up to guard against it.

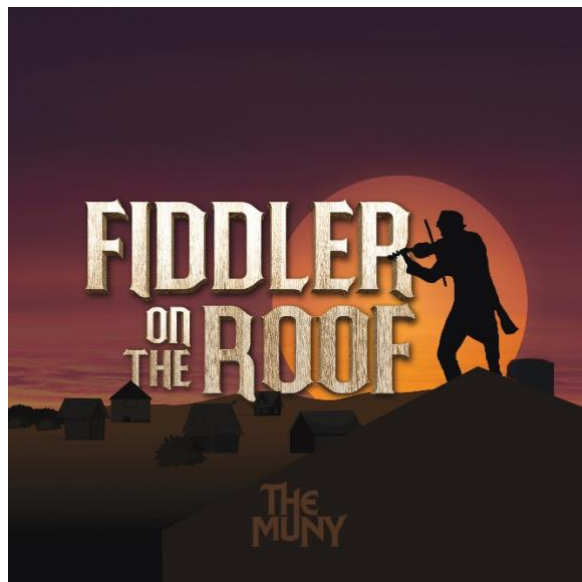
